### **MATCH FORMAT / ORDER OF PLAY**

#### **Boys & Girls Tournaments**

- ◆ Each match to consist of 5 rubbers – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> singles + 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> doubles.
- ◆ All rubbers will be 'best of 3' games, played to 15 points, girls played to 11 points.
- ◆ 1 point being scored per match
- ◆ The total number of points at the end of the tournament determines the final placing (i.e. NO play-offs).

There are two courts available for each match for boys, four courts for girls match.

#### **Mixed Doubles Tournament**

- ◆ To be contested by the #5 players in each team

#### **Tournament Shuttle**

- ◆ RLC –Feather

#### **Set Breaker**

- ◆ Set at 14 points (3 points), girls at 10 points

#### **Tournament Tie-Breaker**

Tiebreaker in the event of two teams gaining equal points at the end of the round-robin tournament:

1. Head-to-head result.
2. Individual games won.
3. Points won.

#### **Discipline**

In the case of ill discipline on court i.e., verbal / racket abuse, disputed line-calls, gamesmanship etc the following policy will be applied:

1. a neutral coach will be asked to supervise the rubber;
2. if the supervising coach is subsequently required to talk to a player regarding their conduct on court a point will be removed from the player concerned;
3. on the second warning a game will be awarded to the opponent;
4. on the third warning the match will be forfeited and the player disqualified from further part in the tournament.

#### **AWARDS**

There will be trophies for the Champions, Runners-Up and Third Place in the boys' and girls' tournaments plus individual medals for the team.

Participation awards to all players.

The following individual awards will also be made:

##### **1. 'Player of the Tournament' (Male & Female):**

To be awarded to the #1 singles player with the highest number of games won in competition.

##### **2. Players' 'Team Sportsmanship Award' (Male & Female):**

To be voted on by the players during League play.
